Venue Notes

2 Chairs without arms to be provided on stage.

PA requirements

We travel with a QSC PA suitable for small shows with audiences up to 250. For festivals and theaters all sound equipment, to be provided by the venue.

Front of House

A professional quality stereo 4 way system. Minimum Capable of producing 115dB of 20Hz - 20KHz undistorted sound at the mix position.

Appropriate mixing console preferred Digital if it must be analogue, it must have at least 16 channels, proper EQ, and at least 6 channels of Compression. AS well as 2 dedicated digital stereo reverb units and 1 dedicated digital delay unit with tap

Example of consoles will be Midas M32/X32, Yamaha QL/CL, Allen & Heath SQ/Avantis, or better.

Monitors

Four separate mixes please with good quality monitors, free from hums and buzzes and with 31 band graphic EQs. Please have monitors rang out and free of feedback prior to the bands soundcheck.

Staging

On a big stage the boys will dance on the stage behind the mics.

A wooden dance floor with marley covering would be ideal for the boys dancing.

For smaller stages they will dance on the floor in front of the stage.

Lighting Needs

We do not travel with a lighting engineer but really appreciate an LD who is prepared to be creative.

The music is very dynamic ranging from quiet and slow to loud and fast and as such we like lighting to be quite dramatic to reflect the mood. We like floor cans, lighting from behind, haze, dry ice and anything unusual. Lots of flashing lights for big dancing finales if possible.
